



POSTER CONTEST RULES:

Postmark Deadline: December 31, 2018

- ❖ Students who are currently in the **3rd-12th grade** may submit posters.
- ❖ Media may include marker, crayon, colored pencils, watercolor, ink, acrylic, or tempera paint. No pastels or chalk media will be accepted.
- ❖ The theme, “**Oklahoma Ag Adventure**” **must** be included in the design of the poster.
- ❖ Posters must be no smaller than 8 ½”x11” and no larger than 11”x17”.
- ❖ **Posters must have landscape orientation NOT portrait.**
- ❖ Posters must be on paper that will allow for duplication, framing, and display.
- ❖ Posters may be flat **OR** rolled; **NOT** folded, matted, mounted, laminated, or framed.
- ❖ Copyright laws prohibit the use of cartoon characters or TV figures.
- ❖ **Submit all entries for state judging.**
- ❖ A copy of the official entry form must be legibly completed and securely attached to the back of each entry.
- ❖ The class summary sheet **must** accompany all class entries. It is to be completed by the teacher.
- ❖ Please make sure all student names are spelled correctly as the spelling you submit will be used to create certificates.
- ❖ A panel of judges will decide the winning entries.

AWARDS:

- One Overall Winner will be selected for Elementary (3rd-5th grade); Middle School (6th-8th grade); and High School (9th-12th grade) and each one will receive a \$50 cash award, citations from legislators, and a plaque.
- 1st place poster finalists will be chosen from EACH grade level and will receive a \$20 cash prize, citations from legislators, and a medal.
- 2nd and 3rd place poster finalists will be chosen from EACH grade level and will receive a \$10 cash prize, citations from legislators, and a medal at a special ceremony at their school.
- Awards will be presented to Overall and 1st place winners during a special ceremony at Ag Day at the State Capitol on April 2, 2019. These winners will also be recognized at their schools prior to Ag Day.
- Each contest participant will receive a personalized certificate.
- Winning posters will be displayed at the State Capitol on Ag Day and will be featured on the AITC website.

Oklahoma AITC reserves all printing rights to entries. All artwork will become property of Oklahoma AITC and will not be returned unless requested by the teacher.
